School Uniform

Ongoing wearing of non-uniform will need to be discussed between school and parents.

Please be reminded that school uniform is:

- Royal blue sweater/ cardigan, with or without the school logo
- White blouse/white shirt/white or light blue polo shirt
- Grey or black school skirt or pinafore; grey or black uniform trousers or shorts
- Black school shoes or smart black trainers

The only jewellery permitted are stud earrings, but these must be removed for PE and swimming sessions.

PE uniform is:

- blue/black shorts and jogging bottoms;
- white T-shirt/polo shirt;
- plimsolls (indoors) and trainers (outdoors).

We now have a large collection of spare PE kit which children can wear should they forget their own. We advise PE kits to be kept in school all half-term.

Home-School Agreements

Your consents and permissions on our Home-School agreements that have been signed in previous years will continue as your child moves through the school. Should you wish to change any permissions, please see the school office staff.

Attendance

Attendance at the end of the school year was 95.4%. This needs to rise to be above 96% to meet statutory requirements. Please make sure your children are in school each day if they are well enough to attend and remember that children should not be taken out of school for holidays or appointments, unless they are agreed exceptional circumstances.

Please remember that the school day starts at 8:55am and NOT 9:00am. Children need to be in school on time as lessons start immediately after registration.

Thank you for your continued support in these matters, it is so important that school and home are working together. Please look out for information from classes regarding your children's projects and homework activities.
