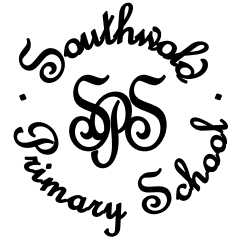

Covid-19 Update

URGENT Covid-19 ACTION: Change to School Time:

- Please note that as of next Monday 21st September, school will close to all pupils in Years 1 to 6 at 3:15pm. This has been agreed by the school governors
- This is because we have had to move to two lunch sittings and reduce the lunch hour to make sure that all bubbles of children are safe and distancing in the dining hall and outside. **Learning time has not been reduced and active time is compensated during the day**
- **Also**, there is congestion at the end of the day with parents waiting for children after they have collected younger children – we need to think about avoiding this
- Morning 'soft starts' between 8:45 and 8:55am for pupils in Years 1 to 6 will continue. Gates will be locked before 9:00am
- **EYC will continue to be dismissed between 2:55 and 3:05pm – if you have older pupils to collect afterwards, please arrive at 3:05pm so that you do not need to wait for long outside main school**
