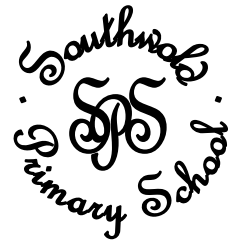

The main symptoms of coronavirus in children are:

- a high temperature – they feel hot to touch on their chest or back
- a new, continuous dry, hacking cough – this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- a loss or change to sense of smell or taste

What to do if your child has symptoms:

If your child has any of the main symptoms of coronavirus:

- Get a test to check if they have coronavirus as soon as possible
