Class Dojo

HOWEVER, if you are reporting your child as absent, please continue to ring the school office and do not send a Dojo message – we need to keep this absence communication system with the office in place please.

Parents' Meeting Phone Calls

So many of you spoke to your child(ren)'s class teachers this week about their wellbeing and progress in school. If you have not yet arranged a phone-call time, please contact school. It is really important that you hear how your child is doing and it is a chance for you to raise any queries or issues.

School uniform/PE

School uniform standards are slipping in a few small cases. Please ensure your child is wearing a **white shirt or polo top** and not a white T-shirt. Please also ensure your child wears their blue **school cardigan or jumper**. Please do not send them in in bright colours- our school colour is royal blue.

Also, please ensure your child is wearing appropriate PE kit: blue or black leggings or joggers - as it is getting colder, shorts are not appropriate if they are outdoors.

Extra layers

We need to ensure our classrooms are well ventilated during these times and classrooms have their windows open during the day. This helps to ensure that fresh air is always circulating, however the temperature outside is dropping. If your child is feeling cold, please send them into school with an additional fleece or jumper (blue/black) that they can wear while working in the classrooms.
