What should I already know?

- Christians believe that Jesus is God and that he was born in Bethlehem.
- Christians celebrate Jesus birth every year.
- Advent is for Christians getting ready for Jesus.
- Christians believe God was Jesus on earth.
- **Christmas** is a time for giving to the poor.

What will I know by the end of this unit?

- The focus of this enquiry is the **Passover** and how it is commemorated today.
- The Jews were captive in Egypt and **Moses** became their leader.
- The Jewish scriptures say **10 plagues** were sent upon us.
- Pesach (Passover) commemorations include Seder meal.
- Christians believe Jesus was put to death on the cross and remember this with Good Friday.
- On Easter Sunday visitors to the tomb found it empty. Mary Magdalene saw Jesus in the gardens. He had risen from the dead.

Impact on believer / daily life

- Jews remember the leaders who showed courage in their actions.
- Remembering the events helps Jews to connect daily with their history and their God.
- Easter Sunday was the day of Jesus resurrection and why Christians celebrate.
