
### Recycling with The Green Team




#### The Green Team met to talk about recycling.

• The Green Team discussed how we could recycle grass, flowers and plants.






#### Composting

You can put some items into a compost bin to make compost.
Compost looks a little like mud/soil, but is full of goodness to help flowers and plants grow.





#### We have 3 Compost Bins at school



These are some of the things we can put in it.



• You should try to fill half of the bin with brown materials.



 You should try and fill a quarter to half of the bin with green materials.

#### Class compost bins

• Each class has their own small compost bin to collect some of these items in.



 When it is full, your class Green Team members will empty it into the large compost bins.



# What to put in your compost bin



Grass clippings



Cardboard and paper



Leaves



Tea bags



Fruit/Vegetable Peelings



Coffee grounds





# What not to put in the compost bin

Dairy products



Meat



Diseased plants



Weeds

#### Making a Class Compost Bin

- You will need:
- An empty bottle





**Compost Materials** 



Leaves



First, put in some soil (make sure it is damp).



# Next, add some fruit or vegetable peelings.



# Then add a layer of leaves.



# Keep adding soil, peelings and leaves in layers until the bottle is full.



### Put it in a sunny place.



If you spot any condensation inside the bottle, remove the lid to let it dry out.



If it looks very dry, then add a spray of water.
