School Day

Please remember that the school day starts at 8.45am and finishes at 3:15pm; ensure that your child is brought to and collected on time. Classrooms will be open from 8:40am.

School Meals

School meal prices have increased to £2.70 or £2.45 for nursery meals. Please pay at the school office.

School Uniform – Awesome Appearance

Most of pupils are looking incredibly smart in the school uniforms. They show such pride in their appearance. Parents/carers are reminded that pupils must wear the correct school uniform and PE kit. Plain black shoes MUST be worn.

(See school website and parent handbook). We continue to promote pupils 'Awesome Appearance' and expectations must be followed. Pupils may bring a sensible sized bag or school book bag with their reading books and school items only as we have limited space in our cloakrooms.

PE days

Children may come to school wearing the correct PE kit on their PE day. They must wear a white T-shirt, black/blue shorts or jogging bottoms, a blue sweater may be worn during the cold weather and plain black trainers. No football kits are allowed.

Jewellery / Make-Up

Children may wear one pair of stud earrings only. For Health and Safety reasons, hoops/dangling earrings, necklaces, bracelets are not permitted. Please do not send your child wearing these items to school. If so, we will ask your child to remove them and return at the end of the day. Pupils are not permitted to wear make-up or nail

Toys/Items From Home

Please do not send toys, balls, colouring pencils etc. from home. We provide each class with a ball and play equipment is provided for pupils at playtimes.

Home Communication

School uses email and Class Dojo to share information with you. Please ensure that you have responded to a Class Dojo text asking you to sign up, if not already done so. It is a free app and you do not need to pay to use it. It can translate into over 40 languages.

Addresses/Telephone Numbers

Please remember to inform the school office if you have changed your address and/or phone number (including mobiles) and email address. It is important that we are able to contact you.

Inhalers/EpiPen's

If your child uses an inhaler or EpiPen, please ensure that they have brought it to school and that it is in date. Any prescribed medicines must be taken to the school office and relevant forms completed.

Absence/Holidays

If your child is absent from school, please telephone the school office. May I remind you that holidays should not be taken during term time.

Behaviour Policy
