


OPAL Play Assembly 3

Opal Play aims to provide all of you with the opportunity to use your imagination and creativity, whilst developing your resilience.




Other Benefits:

- Average screen time per day is six hours.
- Average outdoor play time per week is five hours.
- Percentage of UK children who only play outdoors with other children at school is 56%.
- There are many proven benefits for schools that carry out the OPAL Primary Programme:
 - more enjoyment of school
 - less teaching time lost to disputes between children
 - fewer accidents and greatly improved behaviour.

Our agreed school Opal Play rules



Be Safe:

- Be responsible for positive play
- Do not destroy loose parts toys and play equipment
- Do not attempt to take toys home or hide them
- Be safe when playing and using loose parts
- Look after different play spaces

Be Ready:

- Put your loose parts away in the correct area or bin
- If you notice of discover a toy is damaged give to Team Leader
- Everyone must help and tidy up
- Listen for the whistle and be ready to help tidy up

Be Respectful:

- Listen to your Play Team and follow any instructions or requests
- Use your manners say please and thank you
- Sharing is caring allow others to play
- Do not destroy or damage loose parts play with care
- Listen for the whistle and be ready to help tidy up






- All classes will be given a tour of playground to show Opal Play loose parts and play zones -PLEASE DOT NOT TOUCH THIS WEEK
