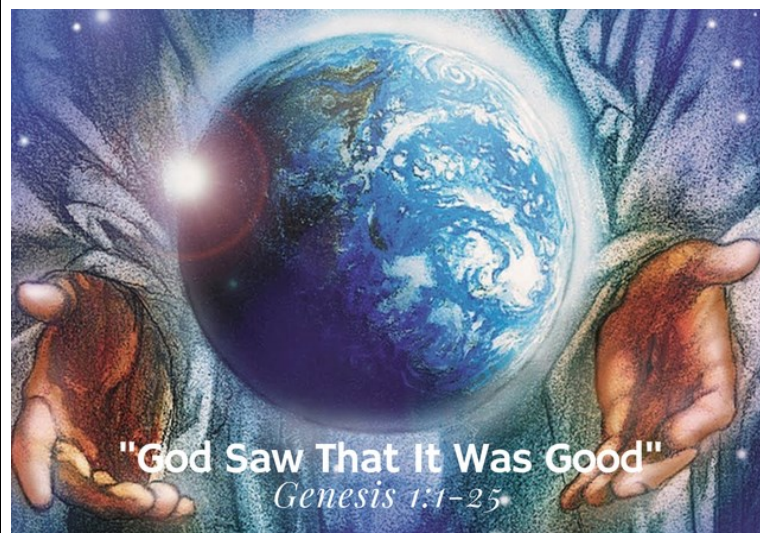

Previous Learning—EYFS

- Christians believe in God.
- Christmas is a special celebration.
- Different people celebrate different festivals.
- There are different religions in the world.

Links with other religions

- God as a creator (Judaism) - Jewish people believe that God created the world and everything in it in six days and rested on the seventh day.
- Waheguru (Sikhism) - Sikhs believe that Waheguru (God) created the universe, the world and every life form within it. There is no creation story in Sikhism.
- Brahma (Hinduism) - Hindus believe the universe was created by Brahma, the creator who made the universe out of himself. They believe it is the power of Vishnu which looks after the world and human beings.
